Or you can print them on a regular piece of paper or cardstock at home and cut them out with a scissors. Either way, you'll end up with a small note of Scriptural encouragement that you can easily tuck in your purse or pocket, include inside a notecard or birthday card, or to hand to a friend when you meet for coffee or lunch. Whoever uses them can keep them nearby for a little dose of encouragement when they need it most.







